Welcome to the Elma Meadows Men's Golf Club. In order to fully participate in the club's weekly and monthly tournaments, you need a handicap.

To accomplish this you need:

- Five (5) rounds of golf at **ANY** regulation course. These scorecards can be attested by any player.
- Once you play a round, you can enter your score on a home computer or club house computer. You should have received your ID# & Password. After 5 rounds your handicap updates on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.
- If you need an immediate handicap call the handicap chairman – [Dave Miechowicz at 684-3647](tel:684-3647). Email [hovich1@roadrunner.com](mailto:hovich1@roadrunner.com). He will provide your first EMGC handicap. At this point, you may begin getting involved in the weekly, monthly and/or major tournaments.

THINGS TO DO AFTER PLAYING A WEEKLY TOURNAMENT. *[Remember, you need two (2) scorecards. One for the tournament and one for your handicap.]*

- After play is finished, return to the locker room to record your scores on the tournament sheet. All cards must be SIGNED, DATED and ATTESTED by another club member.
- Deposit tournament card in Weekly tournament box (one card per foursome).
- Post your score on Clubhouse Computer and deposit handicap card in the Handicap box.

In summary: Tournament scorecards must be attested by a club member.  
Handicap scorecards can be attested by any player.

I strongly suggest you sign up for the **GET ACQUAINTED TOURNAMENT** scheduled for **Sunday, May 21,<sup>st</sup> 2017**. A sign-up sheet will be posted in the club locker room upon course opening.
